We are pleased to announce the 2024 ECA COLLEGE SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM is available to all children or legal dependents of ECA member company employees. Scholarships are available up to \$1,000 annually for 4 years for all accredited colleges or universities.

The 2024 scholarship application is available on the ECA website @ www.ecasf.org.

Eligibility requirement are:

- Applicant must be a child or legal dependent of an employee of an ECA member firm.
- Applicant must be graduating from a Florida high school in 2024.
- Applicant must be a Florida resident.
- Applicant must maintain a 2.5 grade point average from an accredited college or university.

Completed applications must be emailed to the ECA no later than <u>APRIL 19, 2024</u> to <u>eca@ecasf.org</u>. Applicants of completed applications will be notified by <u>JUNE 19, 2024</u>.

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ECA SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS

Dear Applicant:

Attached is an application form to apply for an Engineering Contractors Association of South Florida (ECA) Scholarship. The ECA scholarships are available to any Florida resident that is a graduating high school senior whose parent, parents, or legal guardian is a member or is employed by a firm who is a member of the Engineering Contractors Association of South Florida, Inc.

Scholarships are granted up to the amount of \$1,000 annually for a period of four (4) years so long as the applicant maintains a 2.5 grade point average. Verification of a 2.5 grade point average is required ANNUALLY from the school; immediately following year end posting of grades; it is the recipient's responsibility to forward verification via email or U.S. Mail to the ECA office. Transcripts received after July 31st each year will potentially result in the student losing the balance of scholarship.

Curriculum requirements are only that you attend an accredited college or university. There are no geographic limitations on your choice of school, but you must be a Florida resident to apply. Scholarship applications will be evaluated on the following criteria:

- 1. ACT or SAT scores; official print out from website or valid source.
- 2. School transcript.
- 3. Two or more letters of recommendation, and
- 4. Your 750 words or less typed essay on the following topic:
 - Our attitude is reflected in the things we say and do, and those affect others. What kind of events have influenced your attitude on life? Describe an event that shaped your attitude on life.

Please complete the <u>4-page application</u> and email the application and items listed below in the **following order**: **Neatness and completion of submitting the documents in the correct order is important criteria of your application. **

- a) Your 750-word essay, and
- b) At least, **two letters** of recommendation from someone other than a family member.
- c) High school transcripts
- d) SAT and/or ACT scores

Please email the complete package to the ECA at eca@ecasf.org. An email will be sent back confirming confirmation of your application. Your application package must be received no later than APRIL 19, 2024 for consideration. <a href="mailto:lncomplete applications or those received after application deadline will not be considered.
